

Definition of an Ordinary Member



1. Members of the Club entitled to attend and vote at general meetings or elections of the Club will comprise Ordinary Members and Life Members under the terms of the Club's Memorandum and Articles of Association.
2. An Ordinary Member, for the purpose of clause 10(b)(i) of the Club's Memorandum and Articles of Association, must:
 - a) be at least 18 years of age;
 - b) be entitled to access all 11 of the Club's home games or hold a membership that is designated as a Legends membership by the Club during the Home & Away Season as scheduled by the Australian Football League (excluding practice, pre-season and finals games) (**Home & Away Season**); and
 - c) at the date of the general meeting or the date polling opens:
 - i. hold a membership in any one of the following categories:
 - A. Club 5;
 - B. Legends;
 - C. All other season ticket membership packages (access to all home games), including AFL Club Support Members, purchased with a Social Club add-on; and
 - ii. validly hold that membership for the current Home & Away Season, or if the general meeting or date of polling opening is held outside the Home & Away Season, for the Home & Away Season preceding or following that date.

2.2. For the avoidance of doubt, Ordinary Members do not include persons holding the following categories of membership:

- a) AFL Club Supporter - These are memberships of the AFL where the Club may be selected as the individuals preferred club.
- b) Non-Access Member - Any and all categories of membership that do not grant the individual holder access to games during the Home & Away Season.
- c) Reduced Access Member - Unless designated as a Legends membership, any and all categories of membership that do not grant the individual holder access to at least 11 of the Club's home games during the Home & Away Season do not entitle the holder to be classified as an Ordinary Member.
