Eligible Entrants	Entry to the Promotion is open to Victorian schools that have previously opted in to participate in the Future Magpies Schools Fan Engagement 2026 (eligible entrant) Each validly registered School will receive one (1) automatic entry into the Promotion. Each entry is deemed to be made by the eligible entrant being the School. The School accepts these Terms and Conditions on its own behalf and, where applicable, on behalf of any participating students. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. These terms and conditions set out the rules of participation in the Promotion (**Terms**). By entering the Promotion, you guarantee that you have the authority to accept these Terms and you agree to be bound by the Terms.
2. This Promotion is a game of chance. Skill plays no part in determining the winner.
3. Information on how to enter and prize details form part of these Terms. The Terms must be read in conjunction with the Schedule. The Schedule defines the terminology used in these Terms. Where there is any inconsistency between these Terms and the Schedule, the Schedule prevails. Participation in this Promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms. In the event of any dispute regarding the Terms, results and all other matters relating to the Promotion, Promoter's decision will be final, binding and no correspondence or discussion will be entered.
4. Entry is open only to eligible Schools located in the the Eligible States/Territories who satisfy the Method of Entry. Directors, officers, management, employees, suppliers (including prize suppliers) and contractors (and the immediate families of directors, officers, management, employees, suppliers and contractors) of the Promoter and of its related bodies corporate, and of the agencies and companies associated with this Promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, child or stepchild (whether natural or by adoption), parent, stepparent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, stepbrother, stepsister or first cousin.
5. The Prize/s are specified in the Details of prizes section of the Schedule. The total prize pool is specified in the Total Prize Value section of the Schedule.
6. If any prize (or part of any prize) is unavailable, the Promoter, in its discretion, reserves the right to substitute the prize (or that part of the prize) with a prize to the equal value and/or specification, subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority.

If the prize(s) has not been claimed by the Unclaimed prize draw time and date and subject to any written directions from a State lottery agency, the Promoter may conduct an Unclaimed prize draw in accordance with the Unclaimed prize draw section of the Schedule (if applicable). Without limiting any of the foregoing, in no circumstances will an entrant or the Promoter have any liability to the other for any loss or damage suffered which is indirect or consequential in nature, including without limitation any loss of profit, loss of reputation, loss of goodwill, or loss of business opportunity.
16. If this Promotion is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter, including but not limited to technical difficulties, unauthorised intervention or fraud, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to the fullest extent permitted by law: (a) to disqualify any entrant; or (b) subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority, to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the Promotion, as appropriate.
17. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and Entrants (including a School's identity, location and eligibility to participate in the Promotion). The Promoter may in its absolute discretion not accept a particular entry, may disqualify an entry, or cancel the Promotion at any time where the Promoter reasonably considers it necessary for integrity, compliance, safety or regulatory reasons. Without limiting this the Promoter reserves the right to disqualify any entrant who submits an entry or prize claim that is misleading or not in accordance with these Terms or who manipulates or tampers with the Promotion. If a winner breaches these Terms, the winner will forfeit the prize in whole and no substitute will be offered. Verification is at the discretion of the Promoter, whose decision is final.
